FISHING CREEK PARK – TREE REMOVAL AND TREE PLANTING PLAN (PROPOSED

FOR THE SPRING 2022): Discussions were held on the trees and shrubs within the different Township parks. A count and the types of trees/shrubs document was gathered on January 8, 2022 by Joe Becker. Discussions were held. Discussed putting together a survey for the residents of the Township. Staff from the Township Road Department will assist as needed. The Township Manager submitted the grant application for the TreePA Bare Root Tree Program. Discussed the help from volunteers to help with this project, from school student, UGI employees, and the Scouts. Trees to be planted in a proposed riparian buffer area located at Fishing Creek Park, there are overhead utility lines and potential gas lines in the park, and has access drive/parking area and scattered picnic and fishing locations. Discussions continued on matching the costs, discussed the date for the date of planting and soliciting for volunteers, and discussed the notification of the event with placing notification on the Township website and Facebook page. Lengthy discussions continued.
