## **RECREATION BOARD MEETING WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 17, 2022**

This Special Public Meeting of the East Cocalico Township Recreation Board was advertised and called to order on Wednesday, August 17, 2022 at 7:00pm held at the East Cocalico Township Municipal Building, 100 Hill Rd., Denver, PA 17517.

**FISHING CREEK PARK – POTENTIAL PARKING LOT PROJECT:** Chairman Kulp handed this discussion over to Secretary Brubaker. Secretary Brubaker highlighted the Fishing Creek Park parking lot project, thanking Roadmaster Bret Hoffert, MS4 Ken McCrea, and Recording Secretary Lisa A. Kashner for pulling this meeting together so quickly. Secretary Brubaker handed the meeting over to Ken McCrea for discussions on the environmental aspects of Fishing Creek Park and DEP. Stabilization review of creek was requested of DEP in reference to the proposed millings to the parking lot. Mr. McCrea highlighted DEP's comment, indicating that if a flood elevation is not changed, no permit is needed, which would result in taking away 3-4 inches of the surface at the Fishing Creek Park. Mr. McCrea held lengthy discussions, suggesting that the Woody Waste site is a suggested area to place the gravel removed from Fishing Creek. Discussions were held on after the placement of the millings, the possibility of paving the area, parking barriers, and painting parking space lines. Discussions were held, noting that paving would require taking away even more surface. To place information on the Township website. Lengthy discussions continued.

**MOTION:** Secretary Brubaker made a motion, seconded by Chairman Kulp to approve moving forward with the Fishing Creek Parking Lot Project using milling at the same elevation as the surrounding surface areas. Chairman Kulp asked if there were any questions. There were none. Motion carried (4/0).
