REAMSTOWN FIRE COMPANY VOLUNTEER JASON SMITH GAVE DEMONSTRATION ON THE FIRE COMPANYS NEW iPADS: Mr. Smith discussed and gave a presentation on the new iPads that were implemented within the three Fire Companies. Some questions were asked and were answered.

PAST MEETING MINUTES APPROVAL:

MOTION: Secretary Mackley made a motion, seconded by Vice Chairman Carrasco, to approve the Thursday, October 3, 2019 Board of Supervisors meeting minutes. Chairman Fry asked if there were any comments or questions. There were none. Motion carried. (3/0)

DEPARTMENT REPORTS:

POLICE DEPARTMENT REPORT: Chief Keppley highlighted: A recent donation was received from Dentech, and the Lancaster County Commissioners are meeting on October 29th for discussion on the Drug Task Force.

ZONING OFFICERS REPORT: Mr. Luongo highlighted the report. No questions were received.

ROAD MASTER REPORT: The report will be given at the next Board of Supervisors Meeting.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

MOTION: Secretary Mackley made a motion, seconded by Chairman Fry, approved the Oct. 17, 2019 list of bills: General Fund \$72,042.94; State Fund \$3,823.89; Light Fund \$13,795.30; Hydrant Fund \$14,895.00; Rec Fund \$24,595.00. Chairman Fry asked if there were any comments or questions. There were none. Motion carried. (3/0)

<u>ACTION ITEMS</u>: LAND PLANNING ENGINEER: Mr. Kerschner highlighted the following plans.

TRU-DENVER PRELIMINARY/FINAL LAND DEVELOPMENT PLAN: There was no consultant or applicant representative present. Mr. Kerschner highlighted the project and the status.

MOTION: Chairman Fry made a motion, seconded by Vice Chairman Carrasco, to authorize a \$371,462.00 reduction in the current financial security being held by the Township for the Tru-Denver – Preliminary/Final Land Development Plan, resulting in the remaining financial security being reduced to \$25,000.00. Chairman Fry asked if there were any comments or questions. There were none. Motion carried. (3/0)

<u>ACTION ITEMS</u>: LAND PLANNING ENGINEER (CONTINUED)

LOWELL & CAROLYN MARTIN STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN: There was no consultant or applicant representative present. Mr. Kerschner highlighted the project and the status, noting that the applicant has not yet obtained an NPDES permit.

MOTION: Chairman Fry made a motion, seconded by Secretary Mackley, to approve a waiver/modification of §185-23.A.(2)(c) of the Stormwater Management and Earth Disturbance Ordinance related to the infiltration area loading ratio to authorize a loading ratio of 11.1:1 as supported by the applicant's professional geologist. Chairman Fry asked if there were any comments or questions. There were none. Motion carried. (3/0)

MOTION: Vice Chairman Carrasco made a motion, seconded by Chairman Fry, to conditionally approve the Lowell and Carolyn Martin Stormwater Management Plan conditioned upon the applicant addressing all items outlined in the Becker Engineering, LLC. review email dated October 8, 2019, to the satisfaction of the Township, Township Zoning Officer, Township Engineer and Township Solicitor. Chairman Fry asked if there were any comments or questions. There were none. Motion carried. (3/0)

MOTION: Secretary Mackley made a motion, seconded by Chairman Fry, to authorize the Board of Supervisors to sign the Improvement Guarantee Agreement (IGA) for the Lowell and Carolyn Martin Stormwater Management Plan when signed by the applicant and provided in a form acceptable to the Township and Township Solicitor along with the required financial security in an amount acceptable to the Township and Township Engineer and a form acceptable to the Township Solicitor. Chairman Fry asked if there were any comments or questions. There were none. Motion carried. (3/0)

MOTION: Chairman Fry made a motion, seconded by Vice Chairman Carrasco, to authorize the Board of Supervisors to sign the Stormwater Maintenance and Easement Agreement (SWMEA) related to the Lowell and Carolyn Martin Stormwater Management Plan when executed by the applicant and submitted to the Township in a form acceptable to the Township Solicitor. Chairman Fry asked if there were any comments or questions. There were none. Motion carried. (3/0)

LOWELL & CAROLYN MARTIN STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN:

MOTION: Vice Chairman Carrasco made a motion, seconded by Chairman Fry, to authorize signature of the Lowell and Carolyn Martin Stormwater Management Plan by the Board of Supervisors upon the applicant adequately resolving all conditions of plan approval to the satisfaction of the Township, Township Zoning Officer, Township Engineer and Township Solicitor. Chairman Fry asked if there were any comments or questions. There were none. Motion carried. (3/0)

490 HAHNSTOWN ROAD, CURTIS WEAVER STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN: There was no consultant or applicant representative present. Mr. Kerschner highlighted the project and the status.

MOTION: Chairman Fry made a motion, seconded by Secretary Mackley, to acknowledge the required amount of the financial security to be established with the Township for the 490 Hahnstown Road - Curtis Weaver Stormwater Management Plan in the amount of \$26,283.70, per the approved Opinion of Probable Cost, prepared by Pioneer Management, dated October 11, 2019. Chairman Fry asked if there were any comments or questions. There were none. Motion carried. (3/0)

1925 NORTH READING ROAD – LISTING CONTRACT RENEWAL:

NATIONAL FISH & WILDLIFE FOUNDATION "PA LOCAL GOVERNMENT IMPLEMENTATION" – GRANT APPLICATION: Mr. McCrea highlighted.
