2022 BUDGET WORKSHOP:

Mr. Hession reported that the Township has advertised three (3) 2022 Budget Workshop Meetings to be held on Wednesday, October 20, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.; Wednesday, October 27, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.; and if needed, Monday, November 1, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. Mr. Hession stated that Ms. Lumis will highlight the General Fund for discussions tonight, and then further discussions concerning the other funds will be held at the October 27th meeting, and the November 1st meeting.
